ABOUT THE DELL'ARTE COMPANY

The Dell'Arte Company has been at the forefront of the ensemble theatre movement for over 40 years. Employing and revitalizing traditional physical theatre forms to explore contemporary concerns, Dell'Arte has created more than 45 award-winning original works and has toured regionally and internationally, performing from rural communities like Forks of Salmon to international festivals in Colombia, Venezuela, Brazil, Italy, The Netherlands, Denmark, Croatia, Hungary and France. Always exploring the work of the actor-creator, Dell'Arte has devised highly experimental touring pieces as well as imaginative original family theatre and large-scale 'theatre of place' spectacles at its annual summer Mad River Festival.

Many of the Company's original works, such as "Three Trees" and the annual original holiday show, are ensemble-devised. But DAC has also worked with playwrights such as Lauren Wilson and M. Graham Smith, and adapted classics such as "Peer Gynt," directed by Michael Fields, in collaboration with the Jomfru-Ane Theatre of Denmark. The Dell'Arte Company is known internationally for its dazzling level of performing artistry and unique sense of theatricality. DAC is also acclaimed for its teaching residencies in physical performance styles, having developed a dynamic contemporary acting approach in which body, voice, and point of view celebrate the work of the actor/creator.

SAFETY PROTOCOLS

During these unprecedented times, the Dell'Arte Company has taken unprecedented measures to ensure the safety of our artists, staff and audience during the COVID-19 health crisis. Here are some of the protocols we have in place to combat the spread of coronavirus, while continuing to bring Dell'Arte's unique theatrical experiences to our community:

- In addition to an abundance of opportunities to stream this show via Facebook Live and Zoom, we have partnered with KEET-TV to produce a fully-filmed broadcast of this production, available on local television.
- A handful of fully-masked, socially distanced guests are allowed into the theatre by invitation only to serve as a live audience during streamed performances. These guests are temperature checked before entering the theatre.
- Our ensemble of five actors have diligently quarantined together in a single-household "pod" and are routinely tested in order to be able to perform maskless when onstage together. Mask requirements are in place for the rest of the company while in rehearsal and not onstage.

HANSEL AND GRETEL: A TALE AS OLD AS TIME

The Brothers Grimm (Jacob and Wilhelm Grimm), were German authors and cultural researchers who collected and published folk stories and fairy tales during the 19th century. They were among the earliest and best-known collectors of European folklore, including such classic tales as "Little Red Riding Hood," "Cinderella," "Snow White," "Sleeping Beauty," "The Frog Prince," "Rapunzel," and many more.



The tale of Hansel and Gretel, or "Little Brother and Little Sister," was one of the first oral stories that the Brothers Grimm collected. Tales like this one, which includes a family's children being left in the woods or forest, are believed to have been developed in the medieval period of the Great Famine (1315-1321), when hard times drove many parents to very desperate measures.

The story itself serves as a cautionary tale about the dangers of trusting strangers, but also celebrates the thoughtfulness of children, even during the toughest of times.

VOCABULARY

morsel - a small bite of food.

cauldron - a large metal pot with a handle and lid. Often used by witches for brewing!

ensemble - a group of actors, musicians or other artists who work together to create a performance. You'll be seeing an *ensemble* of five actors onstage in the show!

folktale - a story, often with mythical or legendary elements, made and handed down among the common people.

pontificating - to express one's opinions in a way considered annoyingly pompous.

ceviche - a South American dish of marinated raw fish or seafood, typically garnished and served as an appetizer. What's your favorite food to eat?
